Catskill Hudson AHEC Presents EMS Supervisor's Boot Camp

Since 2005, Catskill Hudson Area Health Education Center (AHEC) has developed and presented the Emergency Responder Leadership Academy, offering an educational forum to leaders in Emergency Services. The 2015 Emergency Responder Leadership Academy was a 2-day event held on June 4th and June 5th in Highland, NY, entitled, "**EMS Supervisor's Boot Camp.**" This workshop was developed and presented by Jon Politis, MPA, NREMT-P, an engaging educator who has presented at many state and national conferences across the United States and Canada. With the knowledge that it takes years to learn the art of leadership and supervision, this 16 hour, intensive and high quality training workshop was designed to shorten the leadership learning curve and provide attendees with the tools they need to ease the often painful transition into leadership.
