Nursing Summit, 2010: 'Mock Trial and Beyond' August 12

Catskill Hudson Area Health Education Center (Catskill Hudson AHEC) will hold its 7th annual Nursing Summit on Thursday, August 12, on the campus of SUNY New Paltz in New Paltz, NY. The purpose of this program is to provide an educational forum for nurses, healthcare professionals, health professions/staff development educators, and students pertaining to issues of malpractice and negligence as well as to provide insight and updates of how to safeguard one's professional practice from risk and litigation.

In this program, attendees will:

- Hear key strategies of how you can lower your nursing practice risk in medication administration, documentation diagnosis and higher-risk specialties.

- Learn the steps you can take to maximize the chances of a successful defense of a malpractice suit.

- Serve as judge and jury in a mock trial simulation and will determine the verdict of a negligence case revolving around a patient admitted to the Intensive Care Unit.

- Learn about current legal issues that affect the nursing professional as a whole and see how documentation affects the outcome.
