Our Annual Nursing Summit provides an educational forum for the nursing profession, presenting timely issues to strengthen the nursing workforce.




ERLA targets professional development in Emergency Service management, administration, supervision, public relations, budgeting, and other areas that are critical to every emergency service's long-term success.




Our annual educational forums incorporate highly relevant topics surrounding the health professions with instruction by experts in the field.
